Make a Crown
 Princess Eliza has invited you to her party - but you need a crown! You can decorate it with whatever shapes and colours you choose. Can you talk about the shapes you have chosen? Maybe you could use them to create a pattern and describe the pattern to your grown up. If you like, you could have your very own party at home!

Challenge Yourself
 The wizard set Eliza seven challenges in the story. Make a list of seven challenges for you to try - one for each day of the week! They could be physical challenges such as running or jumping, making challenges or kind & helpful challenges. I can't wait to see what you decide to do!

Statues
 The wizard keeps turning people into statues. Can you freeze like a statue? Remember to stay very still! Have a game of musical statues - put on your favourite music and dance around. When the music stops you must freeze like a statue! How long can you freeze for? What's the best statue shape you can make?

Story Sequencing
 Princess Eliza uses a different disguise each day. Ask a grown up to help you write out the days of the week on a piece of paper, then cut out the pictures on the next sheet and stick them in the right order. You could draw your own pictures if you prefer!

Potion Making
 Make a potion to stop the wizard coming back. It must have exactly 20 items in it or it won't work! What will you put in your potion? You could have more than 1 of the same thing. Draw or write a list so that you don't forget! Here is my potion, but you can choose whatever ingredients you would like!

Counting Games
 The wizard did a lot of counting on the story! Here are some games that you could try at home

Hide & Wizard (a bit like Hide & Seek!)

- Choose one person to be the wizard. The wizard must close their eyes and count to 10 (or 20 if you prefer) whilst everyone else hides. When the wizard finds someone they must give their best wizard laugh!

What's the Spell Mr Wizard? (a bit like What's the Time Mr Wolf!)

- The wizard must turn around - no peeking! Everyone else asks "What's the time Mr Wizard?" The wizard replies with a number of horrid creatures from his spells (eg 4 snails, 7 spiders, 3 frogs) Everyone takes that number of steps or jumps towards the wizard. When the wizard decides, they can turn around, say "Abracadabra!" and try to catch someone. This person then becomes the wizard.
