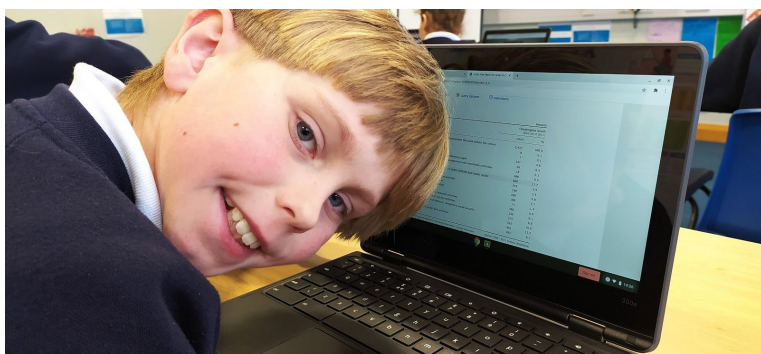
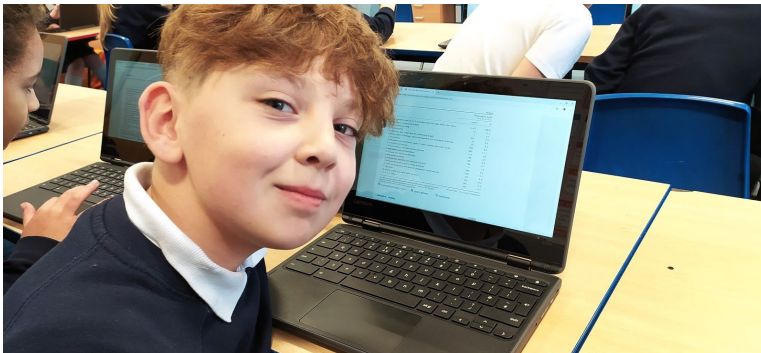
Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been another exciting week in Owl Class.

This week, we have begun to practise our nativity production and have begun to sing Christmas songs too! The children have really enjoyed this so far and they all sing so beautifully!

In maths this week we have continued to work on multiplication and division, with lots of success. We also had the opportunity to use the Chromebooks to log on to Mathletics and do some more practise on the topic. These activities are still available on Mathletics and I have encouraged the children to have a go at completing these at home, if they did not finish. For the children to learn effectively and retain what they have learned, it is important that a small gap of time is left between the newly learned content and revisiting it to practise. Therefore, I am going to make mathletics activities more widely available for the children to complete at home if they do not feel happy that they have remembered something that they have been taught. It is not compulsory, but it is highly recommended, especially as a way to practise content already covered in class.

In Geography this week, we have been learning about the different industries we can find in our local area. By using ONS data as well as data about products we export from the UK, the children learned that the jobs and businesses in Chessington can have a far-reaching impact in other parts of the world!
