

# Owl Class

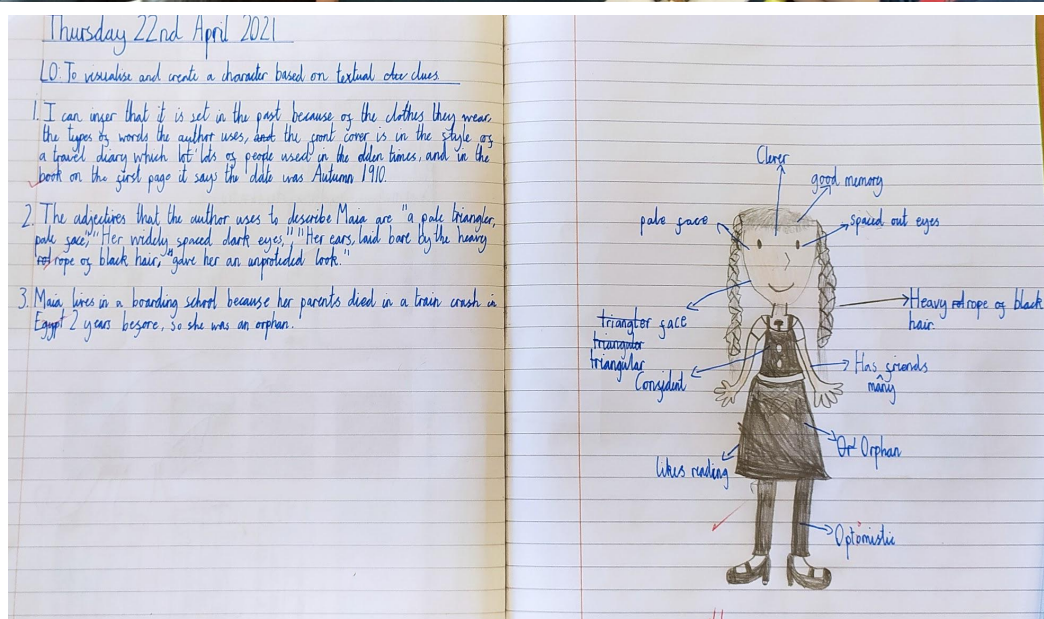
