It has been another busy (as well as slightly damp) week in Owl class this week.

This week, we've continued to understand the setting of our book, *Rooftoppers*, by learning about Edwardian Britain. To that end, we've been researching what London looked like during this period. 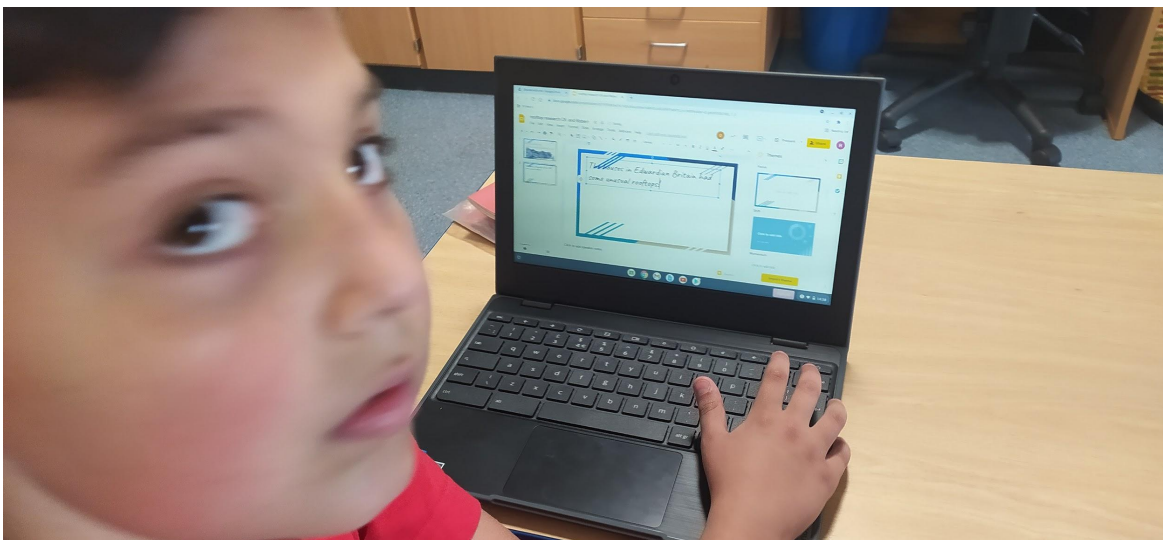
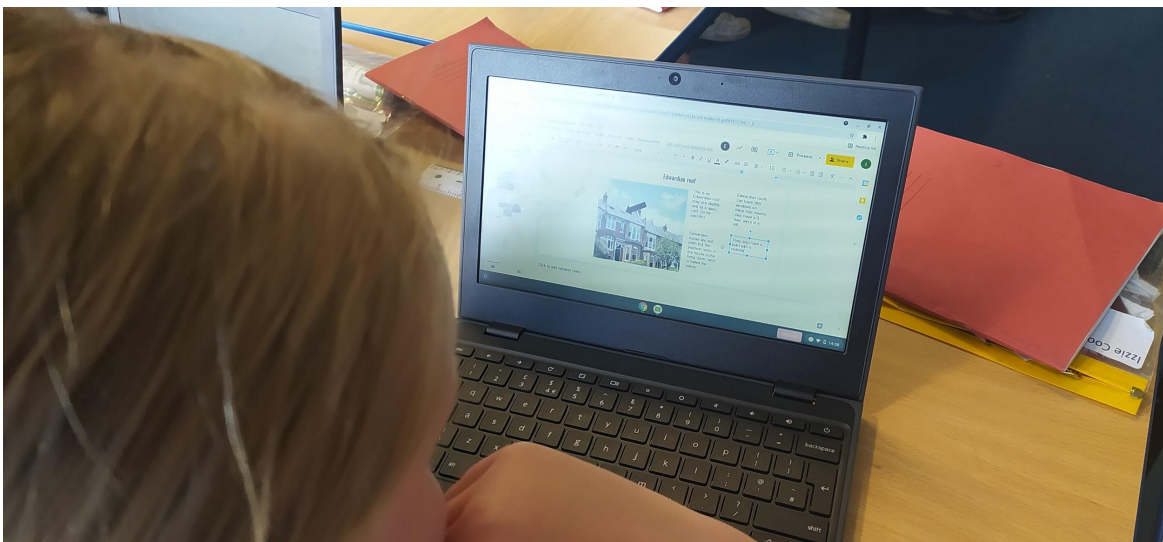
