Kingston Music Service is launching new music clubs for beginners in September 2021.

The groups offer those aged 8-13 the opportunity to make music with like-minded young people. They will meet weekly at venues around the borough of Kingston and are led by expert tutors. There is no experience needed - just a love of music - as group members can learn everything from scratch. All instruments are supplied, with the exception of the ukulele club where students are asked to buy or hire instruments in advance of the first session.
