Easter Card

Can you make an Easter Card for a member of your family and use your phonics sounds to write a message in the card to them?

I can't wait to see what you draw on the front of your card and what you write inside!



Eggs number hunt

Can you draw 10 eggs and write the numbers 1-10 on each egg. Cut out your eggs and ask an adult to hide them in the garden for you. (You must not peak!)

Find all the eggs and put them in the correct order. You could make this harder by doing 0-15 or 0-20.

After you have used the eggs for a number hunt you could put numbers 1-10 in a basket or bag and pick out two eggs and add the numbers together.



Challenge

Egg starts with 'e' how many words can you think of that have the 'e' sound at the beginning or in the middle of the word?

Can you write 3 of the words using your phonics sounds in your book.

Tip: You can always watch 'Geraldine the Giraffe' on YouTube to help you.



Easter Cross

Can you draw or print a cross template and find different ways of decorating it? This could be collage, paint, tissue paper, colouring pencils, felt tips or any other way you can think of. I can't wait to see the designs you come up with and share them with your friends.
