We have added the sounds we have recapped this week to the red phonics books so please continue to practise these at home.

For homework this week, please log onto google classroom. On here you will find an episode of alphablocks to watch and a phonics activity to complete.

To access Google classroom on a computer at home you need to click on to Google Chrome. Then click on the icon of a person at the top right hand corner, it should then open up a log in box.

In this box, you need to type your child's LGFL login followed by @stmaryschessington.school

For example, if the log in is rose078.314, I would type into the log in box

It should then ask you for your password which once entered should allow you to access our Squirrel Google Classroom.
