For homework this week, please log onto google classroom. On here you will find an episode of numberblocks to watch along with a song about the months of the year. For homework this week, please practise saying the months in order. We have also begun to link each month to the season it is in and the weather so you might like to talk about this at home as well.

To access Google classroom on a computer at home you need to click on to Google Chrome. Then click on the icon of a person at the top right hand corner, it should then open up a log in box.

In this box, you need to type your child's LGFL login followed by @stmaryschessington.school

For example, if the log in is rose078.314, I would type into the log in box

It should then ask you for your password which once entered should allow you to access our Squirrel Google Classroom.
