

Hedgehog Class

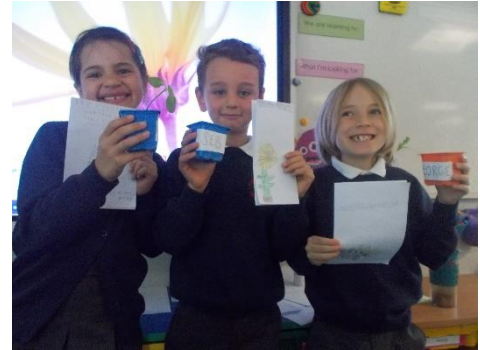

We have had a busy week in Hedgehog Class. We have become artists creating Van Gogh's famous 'Sunflowers' painting in the medium of watercolours.

Continuing our topic 'How does your garden grow?' we have produced a fact file explaining how to grow a sunflower. In the fact file we had to include: a heading, subheadings, bullet points and captions.

Lesteris added this fun fact: Sunflowers track the sun and move to always face it.

We are quite the experts as we are currently growing some in the classroom!



In maths we have been learning all about mass and how to work out how heavy objects are and what terms of measurements we would use. In class we used the scales to compare the weight of objects using cubes as the comparison, e.g. Maisie found out that 2 glue sticks weigh the same as 33 cubes and Lucas C found out that 1 pencil pot weighs the same as 12 cubes.



During our phonics group each morning some of us have been learning about the 'possessive apostrophe' and why and when we use them. Tiffany came up with this idea - Jimmy's treehouse is big.
