Dear Parents/carers,

We have had a wonderful week in Squirrel Class this week. In maths, we have been learning about doubling and halving numbers. I have been so impressed with how the children have grasped this concept and are now beginning to be able to apply their knowledge. **If you have time over the weekend, please do ask your child to double numbers up to 10 and halve numbers up to 20. (For halving, they may need to use paper and a pencil for jottings).**

We have continued our topic of the Great Fire of London and have started to think about the timeline for the key events. We have spent time discussing how the fire spread so quickly, what the community did to try and stop the fire and also why they pulled down houses to stop the fire spreading.

In English, we have been continuing reading about Claude and his adventures, next week, the children are going to be thinking of their own adventure for Claude to go on and write their own story explaining what happens!
